#### PARLOUR

Square mahogany piano forte  
10 ft mahogany dining table  
The two cupboards on each side of fire place as fixed  
Pair chintz window curtains and vallance  
The brown Holland blinds and rollers as fixed  
38 inch Register Stove as fixed

#### ENTRANCE PASSAGE

About 20 ft floor cloth  
5 ft mahogany hat rail and 5 Japan hooks as fixed

#### SITTING ROOM

A cabinet Piano Forte in mahogany case by Searle  
Mahogany music stool covered in hair cloth  
4 ft 6" rosewood pillar and block loo table  
8 imitation rosewood elbow chairs with hair cushions covered in chintz  
Brilliant chimney glass in gilt frame 32x30 w  
The drugget ("a coarse fabric used as a protective floor covering") as plan'd to room  
16? ft square and hearth rug  
9 ft brass window pole with 24 brass rings  
The roller blinds as fixed  
36 inch Register Stove as fixed and extra set of bright bars

#### DAIRY

3 wood milk pails, a bowl, box churn, a dolly churn  
Butter tray, wood spoon, prints, butter scales and 7 brass weights  
Tin milk strainer, skimmer, tin milk can  
A cream can and one other, 9 milk pans, 3 lard crocks  
2 small pans, a white cream crock, 2 yellow milk pans  
Hog killing form, the 8 ft run of cupboard front  
13 ft run of shelving with 2 brackets, 2 pork tubs and lids

#### PANTRY

A salting trough, 6 harvest bottles, a flour bin with 2 drawers under  
13 doz of glass bottles, 28 ft run of deal shelving and 6 brackets
